# Organizational Profile



Ransom ReProgram and Ransom Recycle are Ransom's job readiness education experience and social enterprise which fulfill our mission. Most ReProgram participants and Recycle teammates are returning citizens (ex-offenders) and/or substance abuse treatment program graduates. The programs are open to men and women of all faiths or no faith. The only prerequisites are a free choice and a demonstrated willingness to participate in the classroom and the workplace. Recycle teammates are paid during the entire workday, including time on the production line, time in ReProgram class, and time in counseling. Each teammate is assigned a volunteer coach (mentor) who assists the teammate with discerning and working toward achieving their vocational goals. Ransom Staffing provides transitional employment opportunities for teammates who have demonstrated their readiness to move beyond the Recycle team. This arrangement allows us to extend and maintain our relationship in support of our teammates as they transition into employment outside our enterprise.

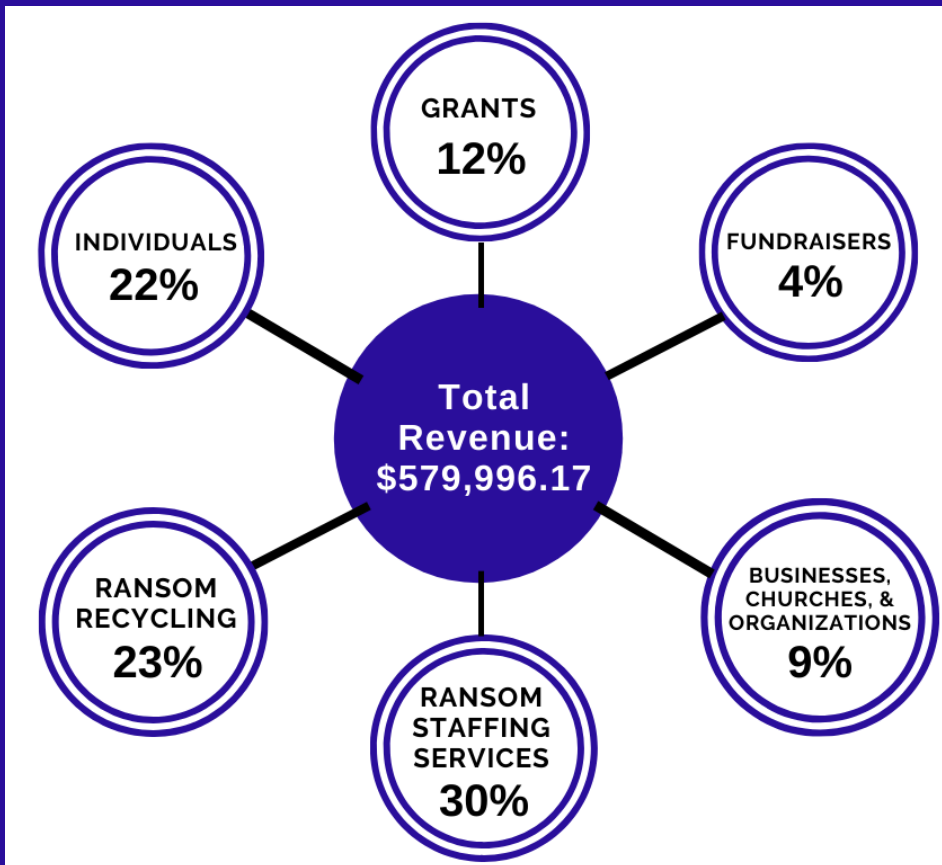

Come out and shop our boutique in Chickasaw Wednesday through Friday; 10AM - 3PM.





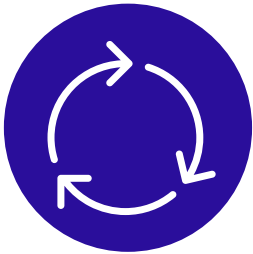

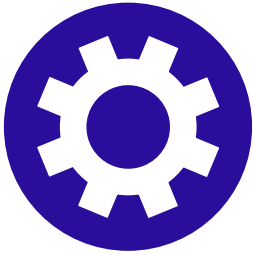
**91 Men & Women graduated from Ransom ReProgram**
